Rod Funderburk is a charter member of the Rotary Club of Lake Murray-Irmo in district 7770. He served as club president in 1991-92, as an Assistant Governor in 2010-2013, as District Governor in 2015-2016. He was honored as Club Rotarian of the Year both in 2007 and in 2010, and District 7770 Rotarian of the Year in 2019. He has served in various capacities in District 7770 including Vice-Governor in 2019-2020.

He is currently District 7770 CART Fund Chair and Secretary of the CART Fund. Rod is a Rotary Foundation Major Donor, Paul Harris Society member, a Benefactor, and a Bequest Society member. He is a Ten Star Rotarian, an RLI graduate, RLI facilitator, and RLI Regional Coordinator.

Charlene has been both a political volunteer and staff member for various campaigns. Charlene was the campaign manager for the late Senator Paul Coverdell in his last race for the Georgia State Senate. In addition, she has had responsibility for recruiting and organizing volunteer workers in several political campaigns. Charlene has served on the National Platform Committee of the Republican Party, and as a delegate to the Republican National Convention.

She has twice served as president of her local chapter of P.E.O., an international philanthropic educational organization. She designed and has led several Rotary training sessions for spouses. A frequent speaker on Rotary's Polio Eradication Initiative including awareness and fundraising efforts, Charlene created a presentation designed for elementary school children on the cause and effects of polio and the need for eradication.

In 2006 she participated in a polio National Immunization Day (NID) in Uttar Pradesh, India. She serves as a Regional Director for CART (Coins for Alzheimer's Research Trust). Charlene speaks frequently about the devastation of Alzheimer's Disease and the need to provide seed money for cutting edge innovative research. She is a 2017 recipient of the Rotary International Spouse/Partner Service Award for Humanitarian Service.

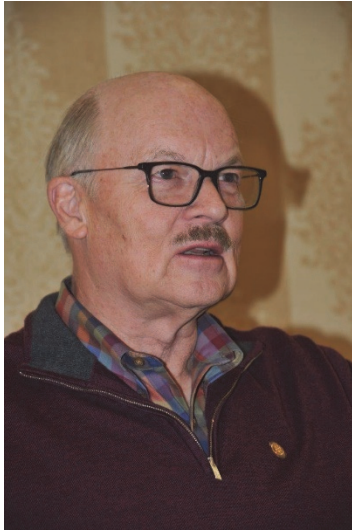

Randy Cook and **Amy Erskine** greeted members and guests.



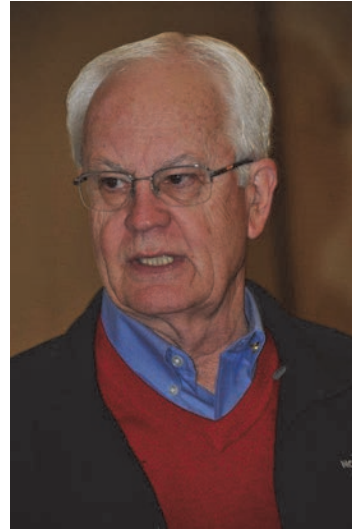

John Brookes stated that the Cobb Senior Services holiday service project went very well.



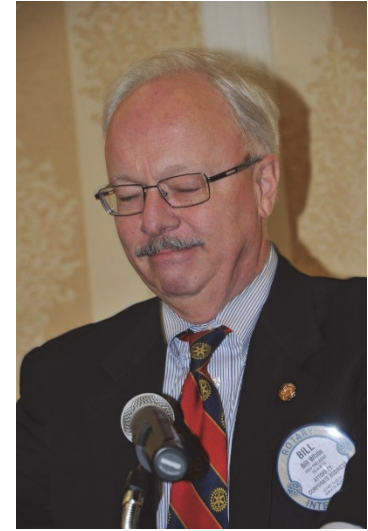
Amy Erskine reminded members about the December 13th holiday party at the Strand and asked members to let her know if they worked a service project and needed a makeup for it.
